The Dumbo Arts Center is pleased to announce its 2nd annual High School Intensive Program beginning in July of 2010. The program will integrate youth into the production process of gallery work and provide a unique platform for part-time summer art-making and art education.

Students will be challenged to produce their own artistic projects under the tutelage of a teaching artist. They will gain valuable experience in event production and arts administration in the areas of: community outreach, gallery installation, technical problem solving and public relations. They will also go on frequent field trips to alternative and sight specific art museums.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be currently enrolled in high school and between the ages of 14-17 at the time of the program.

DEADLINE AND NOTIFICATION

Deadline for the submission of application materials is June 1, 2010.
Applicants will be notified of their status in early June.

TUITION

Tuition is \$950 per student. This includes 18 sessions with our teaching artist, admission and transportation for field trips, materials for art projects, and daily snacks. We may also be able to offer scholarships for students in need.
